The following measure(s) were previously heard in their respective standing committee(s):

HB 65, HD2, SD1 (SSCR1003) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUGS. Allows beneficiaries of prescription drug benefits providers to opt out of the requirement to purchase prescription drugs from a mail-order pharmacy and alternatively purchase prescription drugs from a retail pharmacy. Prohibits a pharmacy benefit management company from restricting a patient's choice of pharmacy from which to receive prescription medications. Prohibits a pharmacy benefits manager from providing incentive copayments to members for the utilization of mail-order pharmacies. Requires affected entities to report to the legislature prior to the regular session of 2018. Repeals 06/30/2018. (SD1)	CPN/JDL, WAM
HB 634, HD1, SD1 (SSCR1016) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT. Establishes job security requirements for certain employees upon the divestiture of a covered establishment if, among other things, the covered establishment employs one hundred or more persons. (SD1)	JDL/CPN, WAM
