The Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) <u>SUPPORTS</u> HB1089 HD1, which would designate October as "Kalo Appreciation Month."

This measure honors the rich culture and history of the kalo plant in October. In 2007, the Hawai'i Legislature passed Act 36 (2007) naming kalo as the official plant of the state. HB1089 would provide an opportunity to showcase the health benefits of kalo as a staple of the traditional Hawaiian diet as well as highlight the kalo plant's historic, cultural and spiritual significance to Native Hawaiians. No other plant more suitably represents Hawai'i.

The traditional moʻolelo of Wākea and Papahānaumoku explains that the first kalo plant, Hāloanakalaukapalili, is the elder brother of Native Hawaiians. As the elder sibling, Hāloa provides sustenance to Native Hawaiians and, in return, we as the younger siblings care for Hāloa by ensuring that kalo flourishes. The bond that connects Native Hawaiians to kalo remains a sacred one, and it is our kuleana to preserve it. Kalo is not only integral to the identity of Native Hawaiians but also to the State of Hawai'i as a whole.

Therefore, OHA urges the committee to <u>PASS</u> HB1089 HD1. Mahalo nui for the opportunity to testify.
