Bill establishes a Unique (U) class designation for taro lands under state jurisdiction within the DLNR Land Class listing and prevents reclassification to other uses once land has received U class status, protecting ancient agricultural structures (walls, terraces, auwai), and auwai where they cross multiple properties and are at risk of damage or destruction. The bill also adds to the State Planning agricultural goals, the goal of protecting and encouraging traditional Hawaiian crops. Protects taro lands from PLDC. We have lost too many traditional taro lands to development and they need to be protected for future use. Taro lands can be found in the conservation zones of many communities and are needed in each community and ahupuaa to support community health and wellbeing. Hundreds of our students and families are returning to the knowledge and practice of growing taro. We need to protect taro lands for these children. Taro lands are often located in high risk areas for floods and ponding. Retaining these lands as taro lands protects communities and reduces liability to the State and Counties.
