Comments: Daar Chair Rhoads, Vice-Chair Har and Committee members, We appreciate the intent of HCR34 to prohibit the use of carbon monoxide (gas chambers) for euthanasia of animals however, this archaic practice has long been discontinued by all county animals shelters in Hawaii. County animal shelters have and continue to conform to both The Humane Society of the United States and the American Veterinary Medical Association guidelines for the humane euthanasia of animals using only approved methods which is injection using sodium pentobarbital. Again we appreciate the intent of this measure but would like to clarify that all shelters have long discontinued CO2 use and are in compliance with all humane euthanasia standards.
