A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT MOTOR VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 105-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "**§105-2 Exceptions.** Section 105-1 shall not apply to:
- 4 (1) The governor;
- 5 (2) The mayor of any county;
- 6 (3) Any member of a police department or a fire department
7 or of the staff of a hospital, or any officer or
8 employee of [~~the~~] a county board of water supply [~~of~~
9 ~~the city and county of Honolulu,~~] when using a motor
10 vehicle for a personal purpose incidental to the
11 person's service or work (but not for pleasure);
- 12 (4) Any officer or employee of the State who, upon written
13 recommendation of the comptroller, is given written
14 permission by the governor to use, operate, or drive
15 for personal use (but not for pleasure) any motor
16 vehicle owned or controlled by the State;
- 17 (5) Any officer or employee of any county who, upon
18 written recommendation of the budget director, is



1 given written permission by the mayor, to use, operate
2 or drive for personal use (but not for pleasure) any
3 motor vehicle owned or controlled by the county;

4 (6) Any officer or employee of the State, or of any
5 county, who, in case of emergency, because of the
6 person's illness, or the person's incapacity caused by
7 accident while at work, or because of the illness of a
8 member of the person's immediate family including a
9 reciprocal beneficiary while the person is at work, is
10 conveyed in a motor vehicle to the person's place of
11 abode, or to a hospital or other place, but every such
12 use of such a motor vehicle shall be certified to by
13 the officer or by the head of the department,
14 commission, board, bureau, agency, or instrumentality
15 controlling or possessing the motor vehicle
16 immediately thereafter, and the certificate shall be
17 forthwith filed with the comptroller, in the case of
18 the State, or with the budget director, in the case of
19 a county; and

20 (7) The assigned driver of a Van Go Hawaii vehicle or any
21 other state ridesharing program vehicle."


Honorable Chair Representative Yamane, Representative Chair Nakashima and Members;

We are in support of this requested law change. When this law was initially approved apparently it did not get Kauai DOW review and comment. The legislature saw fit to exempt the Honolulu Board of Water Supply from the vehicle restrictions and the Kauai Board of Water Supply requests the same exemption.

Employees that are on 24 hour call out are allowed to take vehicles home. During emergencies this policy can change. The KDOW budget is separate from the County budget and this request if approved will have no effect on the County budget. The vehicles are for official use only.

This item does not cost the state anything and allows the various Boards of Water Supply to deal with their employees as allowed in its vehicle policy.
