Comments: Please remove the part that allows planned communities to notice annual meetings by posting on their website. We have a situation in Kuau Bayview with dishonest people running the association, selectively not sending those who would vote them out of office their dues letters, and not notifying people of meetings. It is too much of a burden on owners to have to remember to check the website in order to find out when a meeting is occurring. The only way to fix this is to require U.S. mail notice.
