Chair Luke and Members of the Committee:

The Attorney General takes no position on this bill except to recommend a minor amendment for purposes of clarity. Line 18 on page 17 of the bill establishes a deadline for when the initial members of the council are to be appointed by their respective appointing authority. The Alumni Association of the University of Hawaii, which designates a member to the council, should be subject to the same deadline. Consequently, we suggest that the sentence that begins on line 12 and ends on line 15 of page 17 of the bill be revised to read:

"The alumni association shall designate its representative, and the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the governor shall appoint the requisite number of members to the council no later than ____ days after the effective date of this Act."
