Enterprise Honolulu stands in strong support of Senate Bill 930, the purpose of which is to appropriate the necessary funds to investigate a sustainable concrete initiative produced in Hawaii, contingent on a dollar-for-dollar matching fund from other sources.

The PISCES initiative has already demonstrated the ability to extract key elements from basalt, not only for future exploration survival systems, but also for earth based technologies.
