## SENATE BILL NO. 973 RELATING TO GENERAL EXCISE TAX

Chairperson Nishihara and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for this opportunity to provide testimony on SB 973. The Department of Agriculture supports this measure that provides sales of agricultural products by farmers to consumers within the State, be assessed the same general excise tax (GET) rate as producers under Section 237-13(2)(A), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

A reduced GET rate for farmers selling their produce to consumers within the State would encourage food production for local consumption and support the State's food security initiative.

The Department defers to the Department of Taxation on taxation matters contained in this bill that are under their jurisdiction. We also defer to the Department of Budget and Finance regarding the fiscal impacts of this measure.
