TESTIMONY:

In support of SCR 046 SDI and HCR 46 authorizing the issuance of a term, nonexclusive easement covering a portion of State submerged lands at Lanikai, Koolaupoko, Oahu, for seawall and revetment purposes. The easement is required to resolve the encroachment on State land of a rock blanket makai of the existing property line and seawall in order for a certified shoreline to be issued in accordance with HAR 13-222-19. The rock blanket was approved by the appropriate government agencies in 1968 and is necessary for the stability of the existing seawall. A certified shoreline is required for any construction on the property. The easement request was approved by the Board of the Department of Land and Natural Resources and requires subsequent Legislative and Executive approval. Thank you for your consideration.
