URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & TOURISM TO EXPLORE THE RETENTION OF A NEW PROGRAM MANAGER FOR ITS EB-5 IMMIGRANT INVESTOR LICENSE.

This resolution urges the Department of Business, Economic Development & Tourism (DBEDT) to explore the possibility of retaining a new program manager to run the Hawaii EB-5 Immigrant Investor Regional Center or, in the alternative, to sell or transfer its EB-5 Immigrant Investor license.

DBEDT has notified the U.S. Customs and Immigration Service (USCIS) of the Department of Homeland Security that its present relationship with its current manager will expire in April. We have asked the USCIS whether we have to go through the redesignation and reaffirmation process again if we seek a new manager. We have also inquired with the USCIS whether we can transfer or sell the EB-5 Immigration Investor License.
