

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TERMS OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-123, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3 "(b) The term of each member shall be three years, except
4 as provided for in the initial appointment in subsection (a).
5 [~~Members~~] Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, members shall
6 serve no more than three consecutive three-year terms; provided
7 that the members who are initially appointed to terms of two
8 years or less pursuant to subsection (a) may be reappointed to
9 three ensuing consecutive three-year terms. If a member is
10 nominated to a second or subsequent consecutive term, the senate
11 shall consider the question of whether to reconfirm the member
12 at least one hundred twenty days prior to the expiration of the
13 member's immediately preceding term; provided that if the senate
14 has not taken final action to reconfirm the member by the one
15 hundred twenty-day deadline, the member shall continue to serve
16 until the senate takes final action on the reconfirmation."

17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
