

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the
2 Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2014.

3 SECTION 2. Act 133, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, is
4 amended by amending part II to read as follows:

5 "PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS

6 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
7 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
8 herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of
9 funding specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium
10 beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015. The total
11 expenditures and the number of permanent positions established
12 in each fiscal year of the fiscal biennium shall not exceed the
13 sums and the position ceilings indicated for each year, except
14 as provided in this Act.

2 amended by amending part IV to read as follows:

3 "PART IV. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

4 SECTION 7. The sum of [~~\$14,825,000~~] \$44,185,000
5 appropriated or authorized in part II of this Act for capital
6 improvement projects shall be expended by the judiciary for the
7 projects listed below; provided that several related or similar
8 projects may be combined into a single project, if a combination
9 is advantageous or convenient for implementation; and provided
10 further that the total cost of the projects thus combined shall
11 not exceed the total of the sums specified for the projects
12 separately. The amount after each cost element and the total
13 funding for each project listed in this part are in thousands of
14 dollars.

1 SECTION 4. Part V, Act 133, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013,
2 is amended:

3 (1) By amending section 8 to read as follows:

4 "SECTION 8. General obligation bonds may be issued, as
5 provided by law, to yield the amount that may be necessary to
6 finance projects authorized in part II and listed in part IV of
7 this Act; provided that the sum total of the general obligation
8 bonds so issued shall not exceed [~~\$14,825,000.~~] \$44,185,000."

9 (2) By adding a new section to read as follows:

10 "SECTION 8.1. Provided that of the general obligation fund
11 appropriation for lump sum repair and maintenance, judiciary
12 facilities, statewide for the first judicial circuit (JUD 310),
13 the sum of \$1,340,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for
14 fiscal year 2014-2015 shall be expended as follows:

15 (1) \$500,000 for the plans for fire alarm system upgrade at
16 Hoapili Hale, Maui;

17 (2) \$600,000 for the plans for an assessment of the fire,
18 sewer, sprinkler, storm drain and air conditioning systems for
19 the parking structure at Hoapili Hale, Maui; and



1 (3) \$240,000 for the design of an air
2 conditioning/distribution system upgrade at the Lahaina District
3 Court, Maui."

4 SECTION 5. If any portion of this Act or its application
5 to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any
6 reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall
7 not be affected. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
8 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
9 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to
10 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the
11 extent possible.

12 SECTION 6. If any manifest clerical, typographical, or
13 other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice
14 is authorized to correct the error. All changes made pursuant
15 to this section shall be reported to the legislature at its next
16 regular session.


17 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

19 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
