
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGH OCCUPANCY VEHICLE LANES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part XVII to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§291C- Zipper lanes; minimum number of occupants. No
5 vehicle shall be operated within a zipper lane unless such
6 vehicle has a minimum of three persons. The director of
7 transportation, by rules adopted in accordance with chapter 91,
8 and the counties by ordinance, may increase the minimum number
9 of occupants required for a vehicle to be operated within a
10 zipper lane."

11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
