
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AMMUNITION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 134, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§134- Restriction on sale of ammunition. (a) It shall
5 be unlawful for any person, including a licensed manufacturer,
6 licensed importer, or licensed dealer, to sell or distribute any
7 ammunition to a person unless the person provides proof that the
8 firearm for which the ammunition is to be used has been
9 registered pursuant to this part; provided that a licensed
10 dealer may sell ammunition for a firearm at the time of the
11 lawful sale of that firearm.


12 (b) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty
13 of a misdemeanor."

14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
