
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302D-25, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Charter schools shall be exempt from chapters 91 and
4 92 and all other state laws in conflict with this chapter,
5 except those regarding:

6 (1) Collective bargaining under chapter 89; provided that:

7 (A) The exclusive representatives as defined in
8 chapter 89 and the governing [~~board~~] boards of
9 the charter [~~school~~] schools may enter into
10 [~~supplemental agreements that contain cost and~~
11 ~~noncost items to facilitate decentralized~~
12 ~~decision-making;~~] a single master agreement
13 separate from any other master agreement
14 collectively bargained for between the exclusive
15 representatives and department, as defined in
16 chapter 89;

17 (B) The exclusive representatives as defined in
18 chapter 89 and the governing boards of the



1 charter schools may enter into supplemental
2 agreements that contain noncost items to
3 facilitate decentralized decision-making and
4 address the needs of individual charter schools;

5 [~~(B)~~] (C) The agreements shall be funded from the current
6 allocation or other sources of revenue received
7 by the charter school; provided that collective
8 bargaining increases for employees shall be
9 allocated by the department of budget and finance
10 to the charter school's authorizer for
11 distribution to the charter school; and

12 [~~(C)~~] (D) [~~These supplemental agreements~~] The master
13 agreement may differ from the master contracts
14 negotiated with the department;

15 (2) Discriminatory practices under section 378-2; and

16 (3) Health and safety requirements."

17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Allows the governing boards of charter schools and the exclusive representatives as defined in chapter 89 to enter into a single master agreement separate from any other master agreement collectively bargained for between the exclusive representatives and the Department of Education and supplemental agreements that contain noncost items.
