
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that in order to maintain
2 and improve the University of Hawaii as a world-class
3 educational institution, the State must continue to provide
4 financial support. While academic excellence is at the core of
5 higher learning, athletics is an important complement to the
6 university experience that should not be overlooked. The
7 legislature also finds that the University of Hawaii's athletic
8 teams generate invaluable support and enthusiasm for the
9 university as a whole, and are a major source of pride and
10 positive publicity for the State. The University of Hawaii's
11 prior achievements include an undefeated football season that
12 led to an invitation to the Sugar Bowl. That feat set a new
13 record in ticket sales that exceeded \$5,000,000. The
14 legislature further finds that adequate investment in the
15 University of Hawaii football team, in particular, is essential
16 for cultivating well-rounded students, maintaining community
17 support, and fostering a learning environment characterized by
18 success and achievement.



1 The purpose of this Act is to provide the University of
2 Hawaii at Manoa football team with the resources it needs to
3 solidify and strengthen its football program in a way that meets
4 the needs of our student athletes.

5 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
6 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$3,500,000 or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014
9 for the following capital improvement projects:

10 Men's football team locker rooms,
11 improvements

12 Design and construction \$2,000,000

13 Football team film room,
14 construction

15 Planning, design, and construction \$1,000,000

16 Alexander C. Waterhouse Physiology
17 Research and Training Facility,
18 expansion and improvements

19 Design and construction \$500,000

20 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
21 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$120,000 or so much



1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 to recruit
2 two strength and conditioning assistant football coaches.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
4 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 4. The appropriations made for the capital
6 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
7 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
8 made; provided that all moneys that are unencumbered as of June
9 30, 2015, shall lapse as of that date.

10 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the
11 University of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
