RELATING TO UNITED STATES SENATOR DANIEL K. INOUE DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3 read as follows:


4 "§8- United States Senator Daniel K. Inouye Day.
5 September 7 of each year shall be known and designated as
6 "United States Senator Daniel K. Inouye Day"; provided that this
7 day is not and shall not be construed to be a state holiday."
