
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 444-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2 to read as follows:

3 "**§444-9 Licenses required.** (a) No person within the purview
4 of this chapter shall act, or assume to act, or advertise, as
5 general engineering contractor, general building contractor, or
6 specialty contractor without a license previously obtained under
7 and in compliance with this chapter and the rules and regulations
8 of the contractors license board.

9 (b) A general engineering contractor or a general building
10 contractor who does not possess a specialty license in a craft or
11 trade may perform work that is subordinate to a project, would
12 otherwise require a specialty license in that craft or trade, and
13 is necessary to the completion of the project, only when the total
14 value of the work to be performed by the general engineering
15 contractor or general building contractor is equal to or less than
16 one per cent of the total contract price."



- 1 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
