


- 1 (b) The committee shall be composed of:

- 3 of the legislature whose subject matter relates to
- 4 Hawaiian affairs and water, land, and ocean marine
- 5 resources, who shall serve as the co-chairs of the

- 7 (2) Members of the standing committees of both houses of
- 8 the legislature whose subject matter relates to
- 9 Hawaiian affairs and water, land, and ocean marine
- 10 resources;
- 11 (3) The member of the house of representatives who
- 12 represents the district encompassing the
- 13 Papahanaumokuakea Marine National Monument; and
- 14 (4) The member of the senate who represents the district
- 15 encompassing the Papahanaumokuakea Marine National
- 16 Monument.
- 17 (c) The department of land and natural resources and other
- 18 relevant state agencies shall assist the committee with
- 19 coordination of its site visits."
