# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIFORM MEDIATION ACT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 658H-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3           "(b) This chapter shall not apply to a mediation:
- 4           (1) Relating to the establishment, negotiation,  
5           administration, or termination of a collective  
6           bargaining relationship;
- 7           (2) Relating to a dispute that is pending under or is part  
8           of the processes established by a collective  
9           bargaining agreement, except that this chapter shall  
10          apply to a mediation arising out of a dispute that has  
11          been filed with an administrative agency or court;
- 12          (3) Conducted by a judge [~~who might make a ruling~~] on  
13          [~~the~~] a case; or
- 14          (4) Conducted under the auspices of:
- 15                (A) A primary or secondary school if all the  
16                mediation parties are students; or



1           (B) A correctional institution for youths if all the  
2           mediation parties are residents of that  
3           institution."

4           SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
