# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIRE PROTECTION FOR FIREWORKS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 132D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding two new definitions to read as follows:

3 "Permanent fireworks storage building or structure" means  
4 a building or structure affixed to a foundation on a site and  
5 having fixed utility connections, which is intended to remain on  
6 the site for more than one hundred eighty consecutive calendar  
7 days in a twelve month period for the purpose of receiving,  
8 storing, or shipping fireworks, but in which no manufacturing of  
9 fireworks is performed.

10 "Temporary fireworks storage building or structure" means a  
11 building or structure that is used for fireworks storage for  
12 less than one hundred eighty consecutive calendar days in a  
13 twelve month period."

14 SECTION 2. Chapter 132D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
15 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
16 and to read as follows:

17 "§132D- Storage and redistribution of fireworks. A  
18 person shall only store or perform redistribution activities of




1 fireworks in permanent or temporary fireworks storage buildings  
2 or structures, which shall comply with the applicable county  
3 building code, fire code, or the latest edition of nationally  
4 recognized standards."

5 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.


6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
