
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO KINDERGARTEN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-411, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:


3 "(b) Beginning with the 2014-2015 school year, a child who
4 will be at least five years of age on [~~July 31 of the school~~
5 ~~year~~] the first day of instruction may attend a public school
6 kindergarten. Beginning with the 2015-2016 school year, a child
7 who will be at least five years of age on July 31 of the school
8 year may attend a public school kindergarten."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
