
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GODDARD BUILDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to prevent the
2 demolition of the Goddard Building on the Hawaii State Hospital
3 grounds and convert it to a community center through a public-
4 private partnership with a non-profit organization.

5 SECTION 2. The State shall cease all work on the planned
6 demolition of the Goddard Building on the Hawaii State Hospital
7 grounds.

8 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary,
9 the State is authorized to enter into a public-private
10 partnership with a non-profit organization for the lease of the
11 Goddard Building at the Hawaii State Hospital, and the property
12 thereon, for its conversion and use as a community center which
13 shall serve all community members with a special emphasis toward
14 support for Native Hawaiian children and kupuna. The lease
15 shall be for a term of no less than years and at a rent of
16 no less than \$ per month.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
