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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Act 215, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, is  
2 amended by amending section 1 to read as follows:

3           "SECTION 1. (a) There is established a working group to  
4 review issues relating to the transition of oversight of home  
5 and community-based facilities from the department of human  
6 services to the department of health, including services offered  
7 by or issues related to:

8           (1) Community care foster family homes;

9           (2) Adult residential care homes;

10          (3) Adult day care centers;

11          (4) Caregivers of persons with developmental or  
12 intellectual disabilities;

13          (5) Adult foster homes;

14          (6) Licensed case management agencies; [~~and~~]

15          (7) Fees, rules, and regulations that affect all of these  
16 care setting providers[-];

17          (8) Possible license renewal fees for all care homes and  
18             foster homes;



- 1        (9) The services of case managers provided to individuals
- 2            in care homes and foster homes;
- 3        (10) The services of Community Ties of America for care
- 4            homes and foster homes in the State;
- 5        (11) License requirements for new care homes and foster
- 6            homes; and
- 7        (12) Appropriate liability insurance coverage for care
- 8            homes and foster homes.

9        (b) The working group shall be convened by the chairs of  
 10 the house of representatives and senate committees on [~~human~~  
 11 ~~services-~~] health. The working group shall consist of:

- 12        (1) The chairs of the house of representatives and senate
- 13            committees on [~~human services-~~] health, who shall
- 14            serve as co-chairs;
- 15        (2) [~~One representative~~] \_\_\_\_\_ representatives from the

- 17        (3) One representative from the department of health;

6 president and [~~one representative~~] \_\_\_\_\_  
7 \_\_\_\_\_ representatives shall be appointed by the speaker of  
8 the house of representatives.

9 (c) Members shall serve without compensation and shall not  
10 be considered state employees based solely upon their  
11 participation in the working group.

12 (d) The working group shall submit a written report of its  
13 findings and recommendations, including any proposed  
14 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior  
15 to the convening of the regular [~~session~~] sessions of 2014[~~-~~]  
16 and 2015.

17 (e) The working group shall terminate on June 30, [~~2014-~~]  
18 2015."

20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2014.
