
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NUISANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 322-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§322-1 Removal, prevention.** The department of health and
4 its agents shall examine into all nuisances, foul or noxious
5 odors, gases or vapors, water in which mosquito larvae exist,
6 sources of filth, and all causes of sickness or disease, on
7 shore, and in any vessel, which may be known to them or brought
8 to their attention, which in their opinion are dangerous or
9 injurious to health, and into any and all conditions created or
10 existing which cause or tend to cause sickness or disease or to
11 be dangerous or injurious to health, and shall cause the same to
12 be abated, destroyed, removed, or prevented.

13 For purposes of this part, a nuisance shall include:

14 (1) Toxic materials that are used in or by-products of the
15 manufacture or conversion of methamphetamine, and
16 clandestine drug labs that manufacture
17 methamphetamine; [~~and~~]



1 (2) Odors and filth resulting from a person feeding feral
2 birds[-]; and

3 (3) Odors, filth, and the infestation of rodents or pests
4 resulting from the storage of personal property that
5 is not maintained or kept in good order."


6 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
7 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
8 begun before its effective date.

9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
