
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the
2 Hawaii community development authority shall be prohibited from
3 approving any plans or proposals for development in the Kakaako
4 community development district pursuant to part II of chapter
5 206E, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

6 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
7 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
8 begun before its effective date.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014, and
10 shall be repealed on June 30, 2015.
