
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OUTDOOR HERITAGE MONTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. On September 2, 1937, the Federal Aid in
2 Wildlife Restoration Act, commonly referred to as the Pittman-
3 Robertson Act, was signed into law. Using funds from excise
4 taxes received from the sale of sporting arms and archery
5 equipment, the Pittman-Robertson Act provides federal assistance
6 to states for projects to manage, enhance, and restore wildlife
7 and to conduct state hunter education programs.

8 The purpose of this Act is to recognize Hawaii's commitment
9 to the preservation of natural resources and promotion of
10 outdoor recreational activities by designating the month of June
11 as Outdoor Heritage Month.

12 SECTION 2. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
13 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
14 read as follows:

15 "§8- Outdoor heritage month. The month of June shall
16 be known and designated as "Outdoor Heritage Month" to celebrate
17 Hawaii's diverse natural environment and recreational
18 activities."



- 1 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
