
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUNTING LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 183D-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The hunting license fee shall be:

4 (1) \$10 for any person who has resided in the State for
5 one year or longer, or who is a member of the armed
6 forces of the United States on active duty and the
7 spouse and children thereof, or who elects to forgo
8 the exemption provided in paragraph (4);

9 (2) \$95 for all other persons;

10 (3) \$50 for a three-day period and \$95 for a seven-day
11 period for hunting on a private and commercial
12 shooting preserve for persons who do not meet the
13 requirements of paragraph (1) or (4); ~~and~~

14 (4) Free to all Hawaii residents sixty-five years of age
15 or older and to all persons with Hansen's disease who
16 are residents of Kalaupapa, Molokai ~~[-]~~; and

17 (5) \$3 for all qualified disabled veterans who are
18 residents of the State. For purposes of this section,



1 "qualified disabled veteran" means an honorably
2 discharged veteran who:
3 (A) Has a service connected disability, as defined by
4 the Veterans Administration, consisting of:
5 (i) The loss of the use of a lower extremity; or
6 (ii) A disability rating of sixty per cent or
7 more,
8 and who is receiving compensation from the United
9 States for the disability, or
10 (B) Is the recipient of a purple heart from the
11 United States Department of Defense.

12 SECTION 2. Section 183D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 "**§183D-23 Licenses expire when.** All licenses shall expire
15 on June 30 next following the date of issuance, except for
16 licenses obtained pursuant to section 183D-22(b) (3) [-] and 183D-
17 22(b) (5). A license issued pursuant to section 183D-22(b) (5)
18 shall expire upon the death of the licensee. Nothing in this
19 section shall be construed to prohibit the department from
20 suspending or revoking any hunting license."

21 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
22 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
