
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FARMERS MARKETS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 486, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§486- Non-Hawaii-made products; farmers markets. No
5 person shall keep, offer, display or expose for sale, or solicit
6 for the sale of any item, product, souvenir, or any other
7 merchandise at a farmers' market that has not been manufactured,
8 assembled, fabricated, cultivated, or produced within the State
9 and has not had at least fifty-one per cent of its wholesale
10 value added by manufacture, assembly, fabrication, cultivation,
11 or production within the State unless the item, product,
12 souvenir, or merchandise is labelled "made out-of-state" or that
13 by any other means represents the origin of the item, product,
14 souvenir, or merchandise as being from a place outside the
15 State.

16 For the purposes of this section, "farmers' market" means
17 an outdoor market composed of independent business operators who
18 sell goods or services to the public."
