
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LABOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302D-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The State shall afford administrative, support, and
4 instructional employees in charter schools full participation in
5 the State's systems for retirement, workers' compensation,
6 unemployment insurance, temporary disability insurance, sick
7 leave, vacation, leave sharing, and health benefits as well as
8 additional support and incentives offered by the department
9 including, but not limited to, hard-to-staff incentives,
10 national board certification incentives, special education
11 teacher incentives, bonuses for completion of probation, and
12 teacher licensing fees, in accordance with the qualification
13 requirements for each."


