
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VETERANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:
4 "§286-109.3 Designation of a Veteran. On the application
5 form for any driver's license or license renewal, the examiner
6 of drivers shall ask the applicant to designate whether the
7 applicant is a United States military Veteran. Provided at the
8 time of issuance of the license the applicant produces a valid
9 DD214 the examiner of drivers shall issue or renew a license
10 bearing the designation "Veteran", a symbol, or an abbreviation
11 thereof, for those applicants who have so produced. For the
12 purposes of this section "Veteran" means an individual who has
13 served in an active duty status in United States military, naval
14 or air force for at least 20 years of active duty service and
15 who was discharged or released under conditions other than
16 dishonorable.

17 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
