
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to remove the sunset
2 provision in Act 19, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, thereby
3 permanently allowing the director of commerce and consumer
4 affairs to designate an access organization to oversee public,
5 educational, and governmental channels.

6 SECTION 2. Act 19, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, is amended
7 by amending section 4 to read as follows:

8 "SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011[~~7~~
9 ~~provided that this Act shall be repealed on June 30, 2014, and~~
10 ~~section 440C-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in~~
11 ~~the form in which it read on the day prior to the effective date~~
12 ~~of this Act]."~~

13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14 and stricken.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2014.


