
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR STATE LIFEGUARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Lifeguards serve an essential function in a
2 state surrounded by ocean and numerous freshwater attractions.
3 Lifeguards rescue potential drowning victims, administer first
4 aid, and teach water safety. Lifeguards allow the public to
5 enjoy the natural beauty of our waters and contribute to
6 Hawaii's reputation as a desirable place to live and visit.

7 The legislature finds that the island of Hawaii does not
8 have state-funded lifeguards at Kua Bay, Kekaha Kai state park.

9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for
10 lifeguards at Kua Bay, Kekaha Kai state park, island of Hawaii,
11 an area under the jurisdiction of the department of land and
12 natural resources.

13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000 or so much
15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the
16 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
17 2014-2015 for salaries, benefits, equipment, and other related
18 expenses, to employ lifeguards for the island of Hawaii.

1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
2 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
