
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
EIGHTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2014-2015.

5 1. To be expended by the department of land and natural
6 resources:

7 A. Kalauhaehae Fishpond (Lucas Spring), Niu Valley, Oahu
8 Demolish abandoned home and restore spring and
9 fishpond area to what it was like before the
10 Kalaniana'ole Highway widening project in the early
11 1990's.




1 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective
