
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-NINTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$27,795,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-
6 ninth representative district, as follows:

7 1. To be expended by the department of budget and finance:

9 Deferred maintenance projects including repaving parking
10 lots; upgrade to fire/safety projects.

17 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
18 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
19 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

20 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
21 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by
22 the designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
