A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to change the 2 formula for crediting unused sick leave when a public employee 3 retires or leaves government service. The legislature finds that this Act is necessary to reduce the public employers' 4 5 contributions to the Employees' Retirement System of the State of Hawaii. 6 7 SECTION 2. Section 88-63, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: 8 9 "[+] \$88-63[+] Credit for unused sick leave. (a) This 10 subsection shall apply to public employees who became members of 11 the system before July 1, 2014. 12 A public employee, to whom this subsection applies, who 13 retires or leaves government service in good standing with sixty 14 days or more of unused sick leave shall be entitled to 15 additional service credit in the [retirement] system as follows:
- 16 (1) An employee with sixty days of unused sick leave to 17 the employee's credit shall have the employee's years

3	(2)	For each additional twenty days or major fraction

4	(c) The allowance on service retirement of section 88-74
5	and the service benefit limitation therein shall not apply to

8	retirement allowances and no reduction in such retirement
9	allowances shall be made on account of such limitations."
10	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECTION 4. This Act, upon its approval, shall take effect
13	on July 1, 2014.
