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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RECORDS OF THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 323F-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:  
3           "§323F-6 Records. (a) The corporation and each regional  
4 system board shall be subject to the requirements of chapter  
5 92F, except that the following categories of government records  
6 shall not be required to be disclosed:  
7           (1) Applications for credentials or staff privileges at  
8           any of the corporation's medical facilities, records  
9           from peer review proceedings, and medical records; and  
10          (2) Marketing strategies, strategic plans, evaluations,  
11          assessments, negotiations, or rates and charges, the  
12          disclosure of which would raise the cost of  
13          procurement or give a manifestly unfair advantage to  
14          any competitor or to any person or entity seeking to  
15          do business or proposing to enter into an agreement  
16          with a regional system board, the corporation, or any  
17          of its facilities.



1 Any person denied access to any such government records shall  
2 have available the remedies specified in sections 92F-15 and  
3 92F-15.5. Government records protected from disclosure by this  
4 section shall be subject to the interagency disclosure  
5 provisions of section 92F-19. Section 624-25.5 shall apply to  
6 this part notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in  
7 this section.

8 (b) Notwithstanding section 92-21 and chapter 92F to the  
9 contrary, the corporation shall have the authority to set a flat  
10 rate for searching for, reviewing, segregating, and copying  
11 medical records, whether requested pursuant to chapter 92F, by  
12 subpoena, or in some other manner; provided that the rate for  
13 copying shall be no less than \$1 per page and no more than \$2  
14 per page."

15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
17 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
18 begun before its effective date.

19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Hawaii Health Systems Corporation

**Description:**

Authorizes the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation to set a flat rate for searching for, reviewing, segregating, and copying medical records. Effective July 1, 2050. Provides that the rate for copying medical records shall be no less than \$1 per page and no more than \$2 per page. Effective July 1, 2050.
