A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a need to
- 2 upgrade the methods and procedures for state certificates of
- 3 inspection for motor vehicles. This Act reduces the amount of
- 4 insurance information required on an inspection certificate.
- 5 This will reduce data entry requirements for inspectors without
- 6 degrading the function of checking insurance cards. Digital
- 7 images of the cards will be stored for easy retrieval should a
- 8 need for additional information arise. In addition, this Act
- 9 withdraws the opportunity to replace lost, stolen, or destroyed
- 10 inspection stickers without reinspection.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 286-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
- "(e) Upon application for a certificate of inspection to
- 14 be issued for a vehicle, an inspection as prescribed by the
- 15 director under subsection (g) shall be conducted on the vehicle,
- 16 and if the vehicle is found to be in [a safe operating
- 17 condition, compliance with the inspection requirements, a
- 18 certificate of inspection shall be issued upon payment of a fee HB2352 HD1 HMS 2014-1845



- 1 to be determined by the director. The certificate shall state
- 2 the [effective date, the termination date, the name of the
- 3 issuing insurance carrier, and the policy number of insurance
- 4 expiration date shown on the motor vehicle insurance
- 5 identification card for the inspected motor vehicle as specified
- 6 by section 431:10C-107, a certificate of self-insurance issued
- 7 by the state insurance commissioner, or state the information
- 8 contained in the proof of insurance card as specified by section
- 9 431:10G-106. A validation sticker, authorized by the director,
- 10 shall be affixed to the vehicle at the time a certificate of
- 11 inspection is issued. [An-inspection sticker which has been
- 12 lost, stolen, or destroyed shall-be-replaced without
- 13 reinspection by the inspection station that issued the original
- 14 inspection sticker upon presentation of the vehicle's current
- 15 certificate of inspection; provided that the current certificate
- 16 of inspection and inspection sticker shall not have expired at
- 17 the time the replacement is requested. The director shall adopt
- 18 rules to determine the fee for replacement of lost, stolen, or
- 19 destroyed inspection stickers.]
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 21 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 22 begun, before its effective date.
