
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN KONOHIKI MANAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 171-4.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:

3 "(d) The aha moku advisory committee may provide advice on
4 the following:

5 (1) Integrating indigenous resource management practices
6 with western management practices in each moku;

7 (2) Identifying a comprehensive set of indigenous
8 practices for natural resource management;

9 (3) Fostering the understanding and practical use of
10 native Hawaiian resource knowledge, methodology, and
11 expertise;

12 (4) Sustaining the State's marine, land, cultural,
13 agricultural, and natural resources;

14 (5) Providing community education and fostering cultural
15 awareness on the benefits of the aha moku system;

16 (6) Fostering protection and conservation of the State's
17 natural resources; [~~and~~]



- 1 (7) Developing an administrative structure that oversees
- 2 the aha moku system[-]; and
- 3 (8) Establishing and applying traditional Hawaiian
- 4 konohiki management practices to restore fishery food
- 5 stocks and environmental well-being, in consultation
- 6 with members of fishery communities engaging in
- 7 traditional Hawaiian fishery sustainability
- 8 practices."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect July 1, 2030.
