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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR CORRECTIONAL  
FACILITIES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, due to the State's  
2 liability for individuals detained or incarcerated in state  
3 correctional facilities, the State must maintain certain  
4 standards in those facilities to ensure the safety of the  
5 general public, facility staff and administration, and  
6 incarcerated individuals. The purpose of this Act is to provide  
7 funding for planning and site development necessary to meet  
8 facility standards by upgrading or replacing aging correctional  
9 facilities to address concerns such as inmate overcrowding.

10           SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
11 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$9,500,000 or so much  
12 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015  
14 for the purpose of improving Hawaii's correctional facilities  
15 through capital improvement projects for facility planning and  
16 site development, as follows:

15 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are

16 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are

17 unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

18 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the

19 department of public safety for this purposes of this Act.

20 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
