

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:


1	SECTION 1. Act 178, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, is
2	amended by amending section 3 to read as follows:
3	"SECTION 3. Section 302A-411, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended to read as follows:
5	<pre>"§302A-411 Kindergarten program; establishment;</pre>
6	attendance. (a) The department shall establish and maintain
7	kindergartens with a program of instruction as a part of the
8	public school system; provided that:
9	(1) Attendance shall not be mandatory; and
10	(2) Charter schools shall be excluded from mandatory
11	participation in the program.
12	(b) Beginning with the 2014-2015 school year, a child who
13	will be at least five years of age on [July 31] <u>December 31</u> of
14	the school year may attend a public school kindergarten.
15	(c) The department may accept gifts to establish and
16	maintain kindergartens.""
