### A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE I, SECTION 23, OF THE HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION TO RESERVE MARRIAGE TO OPPOSITE-SEX COUPLES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
2	amendment to article I, section 23, of the Constitution of the
3	State of Hawaii to reserve marriage to opposite-sex couples.
4	SECTION 2. Article I, section 23, of the Constitution of
5	the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:
6	"MARRIAGE
7	Section 23. [The legislature shall-have the power to
8	<del>reserve marriage</del> ] <u>Marriage shall be reserved</u> to opposite-sex
9	couples."
10	SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
11	be as follows:
12	"Shall the Constitution of the State of Hawaii be amended
13	to reserve marriage to opposite-sex couples?"
14	SECTION 4. Constitutional material to be repealed is
15	bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is
16	underscored.
