- 4 ""Disability" means total inability of an employee to
- 5 perform the duties of the employee's employment caused by
- 6 sickness, pregnancy, termination of pregnancy, organ donation,
- 7 or accident other than a work injury as defined in section 386-
- 8 3."

- 9 SECTION 2. Section 392-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) Any individual in current employment who suffers
- 12 disability resulting from accident, sickness, pregnancy, $[ext{ex}]$
- 13 termination of pregnancy, or organ donation, except accident or
- 14 disease connected with or resulting from employment as defined
- 15 in section 386-3 or any other applicable workers' compensation
- 16 law, shall be entitled to receive temporary disability benefits
- 17 in the amount and manner provided in this chapter."

- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
