

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE TWENTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$4,715,00 and the same
3	sum or so much there of is appropriated out of the general
4	revenues of the State of Hawaii or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the purpose of improving
6	school facilities in the twenty-first representative district,
7	as follows.

improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are
made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that
remain unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that
date.
SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.
SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
