
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$4,715,00 and the same
3 sum or so much there of is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the purpose of improving
6 school facilities in the twenty-first representative district,
7 as follows.

8 To be expended by the department of accounting and general
9 services:

10 A. Ala Wai elementary school, Oahu

11 Replacement classroom chairs and desks.

15 Planning, design, and construction of a

2 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
3 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
4 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are
5 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that
6 remain unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that
7 date.

8 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
9 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
10 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
