A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LABOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 104-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) This chapter shall apply to every contract in excess 4 of \$2,000 for construction of a public work project to which a 5 governmental contracting agency is a party; provided that this 6 chapter shall not apply to experimental and demonstration 7 housing developed pursuant to section 46-15 or housing developed 8 pursuant to chapter 201H if the cost of the project is less than 9 \$500,000 and the eligible bidder or eligible developer is a 10 private nonprofit corporation. 11 For the purposes of this subsection: 12 "Contract" includes but is not limited to any agreement,

13 purchase order, or voucher in excess of \$2,000 for construction 14 of a public work project.

15 "Governmental contracting agency" includes [any]:

16 (1) Any person or entity that causes either directly or

(2) Public-private partnerships.

Party" includes eligible bidders for and eligible
developers of any public work and any housing under chapter
201H; provided that this subsection shall not apply to any
housing developed under section 46-15 or chapter 201H if the
entire cost of the project is less than \$500,000 and the
eligible bidder or eligible developer is a private nonprofit
corporation.


"Public work" means any project, including development of 9 10 any housing pursuant to section 46-15 or chapter 201H and 11 development, construction, renovation, and maintenance related to refurbishment of any real or personal property, where the 12 13 funds or resources required to undertake the project are to any extent derived, either directly or indirectly, from public 14 15 revenues of the State or any county, or from the sale of securities or bonds whose interest or dividends are exempt from 16 state or federal taxes." 17




SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


