
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOPEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-195, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:

4 "(a) No person less than fifteen years of age shall drive
5 a moped on a highway, street, roadway, or any other public
6 property in the State. No person [~~less than eighteen years of~~
7 age] shall drive a moped unless the person wears a safety helmet
8 securely fastened with a chin strap. The safety helmet shall
9 meet the specifications and requirements established by rules
10 adopted by the director."

11 2. By amending subsection (e) to read:

12 "(e) [~~Three-wheeled mopeds~~] Mopeds shall be insured for
13 liability and property damage, [~~excluding~~] including personal
14 injury protection."

15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on October 1, 2014.
