
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 58, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, section
2 14, as amended by section 50 of Act 22, Session Laws of Hawaii
3 2005, as amended by section 1 of Act 306, Session Laws of Hawaii
4 2006, as amended by section 12 of Act 5, Special Session Laws of
5 Hawaii 2009, as amended by section 5 of Act 102, Session Laws of
6 Hawaii 2010, is amended to read as follows:

7 "SECTION 14. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;

12 June 30, 2006, by section 1 of Act 137, Session Laws

For the Hawaii Tourism Authority, removes the repeal date of the following provisions: the exemption from Comptroller supervision of accounts; authorization for Comptroller to request annual publication of statements information; the imposition of only statewide uniform accounting form requirements; the Executive Director's state retirement benefits and compensation package adjustments; the grant of appointment authority for a Sports Director; and provisions directing deposit of interest and revenues from Authority projects into Tourism Special Fund. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB2435 HD1)
