BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 448, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

6	(a) Any person who practices dentistry or dental surgery in
7	this State and who prescribes or administers general anesthesia,

9	the licensure and other requirements of this chapter and shall
10	possess written authorization to administer general anesthesia,
11	intravenous-conscious sedation, or conscious sedation as
12	applicable, issued by the board.
13	(b) Any dentist who prescribes or administers general
14	anesthesia, intravenous-conscious sedation, or conscious

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- **15** sedation shall do so in accordance with rules adopted by the

- 17 (c) Any place of practice of any licensed dentist and any

Dentistry; Anesthesia and Sedation Written Authorization

Description:

Requires any dentist who prescribes or administers general anesthesia, intravenous-conscious sedation, or conscious sedation in providing dental services to obtain a written authorization issued by the Board of Dental Examiners. Requires site certification for locations where specified anesthesia is prescribed or administered.

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
